## 1. About Sydney College of Divinity - Associate Degree Course

The Sydney College of Divinity offers 2 Associate Degree courses –

- Associate Degree in Christian Thought and Practice
- Associate Degree in Christian Thought and Practice (Korean)

These associate degree courses require the satisfactory completion of 16 units at AQF7 level (Bachelor level).

## 2. Admission criteria

Admission into the associate degree course is by successful completion of the HSC with an ATAR of 65 or above (for Queensland an OP equal to 16 or less) or mature-age entry. There are no adjustments made to the ATAR score for admission.

Admission into the Korean associate degree course is by successful completion of final year at high school with results that would allow entry into Korean Universities.
